APPLEGATE TRAIL IN OREGON

The SELF-GUIDED TOUR has been arranged by the Hugo Emigrant Trails Committee of the Hugo Neighborhood Association and Historical Society and to be used by persons traveling to the national convention. Considering the many options, it was decided to focus on locations that have historical information signs or interpretive centers.

Four historic lodging/dining locations have been included for the convenience of those traveling this tour.

To fill in the details between the stops we would highly recommend the books that are listed at the end. We are biased towards the book, *A Guide to the Applegate Trail-From Goose Lake to Southern Oregon* published by Trails West, Inc. for the Landrum Wayside to Ashland portion of the route. It is a good presentation. Northward from Ashland we recommend, *Applegate Trail II*, published by Klamath County Historical Society.

TOUR F is a GUIDED TOUR of a portion of the Applegate Trail, and has been organized, planned and will be led by Leta and Joe Neiderheiser. Leta is the great great granddaughter of Jesse Applegate. This tour will include visits to the Charles Applegate house and the Applegate family cemetery and will end at the Jason Lee Mission House in Salem.
