

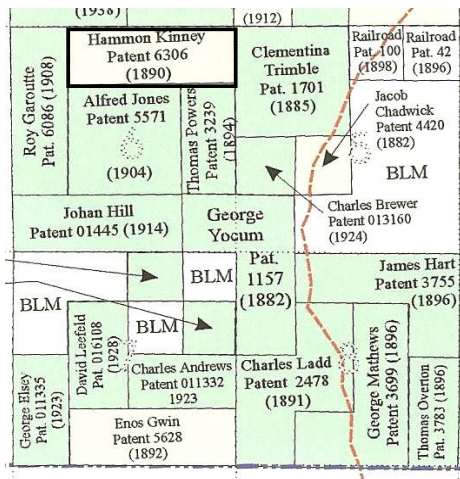

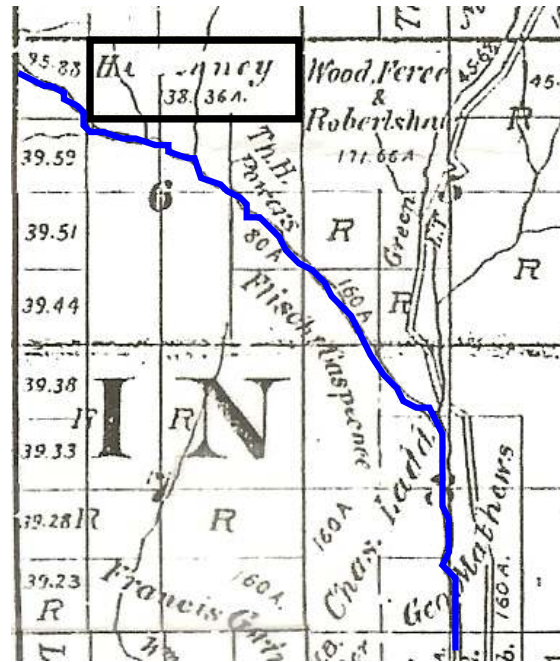


Harmon Kinney Cash Entry: 1890

1890 Hammon Kinney Cash Entry Kinney purchased 138.36 acres under Cash Entry No. 6306 in Josephine County, Oregon. It was issued April 16, 1890 to Hammond C. Kinney (April 24, 1820: Sale-Cash Entry (3 Stat. 566)).¹⁻²

The Hammond Kinney Family, Hugo Pioneers: ca., 1890s

1895 Five years later Kinney was still in possession of his cash entry tract. The ground was high up the Quartz Creek drainage.³
