

Joanna Bryant/Joanna Miller Homestead

1880 Census: Jump Off Joe Precinct Arvilia was the head of household for three people.

Joanna's maiden name is Miller. She married Alonzo Bryant November 1, 1879 in Josephine County, Oregon (Jo. Co. Marriages, Vol. 2, page 289). He is listed with household 64.

A Jacob Miller had an 80 acre cash entry adjacent and north of Joanna Bryant's 160 acre homestead.

Household No. 64 Also in the Jump Off Joe Precinct is the head of household Smith, his wife, three kids, and Alonzo.

1882 Jacob Miller's Hugo Cash Entry In 1882 Jacob Miller was issued a cash entry patent for 80 acres in Hugo, Oregon (Patent No. 4556).¹⁻³

1885 Joanna Bryant's Hugo Homestead On April 20, 1885 Joanna Bryant/Joanna Miller was issued a cash entry patent for 160 acres in Hugo, Oregon (Patent No. 1737).¹⁻²

The Bryants, A Hugo Pioneer Family: ca., 1880s - 18??

1895 Official Map of Josephine County⁴

J. Bryant Map identifies J. Bryant as owner of 160 acres, but different 160 acres than her original homestead. It includes the north 80 acres of her homestead and the old Jacob Miller cash entry of 80 acres.

Jas. Bryant Map identifies Jas. Bryant as owner of 80 acres, the south ½ of old Joanna Bryant homestead.

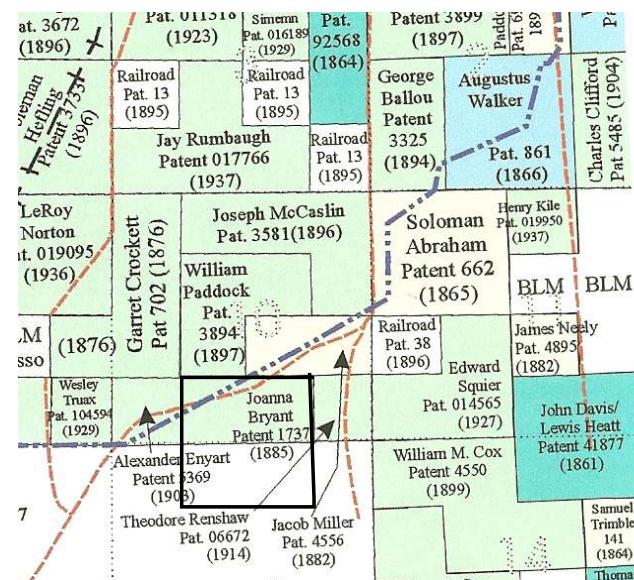
