1895 W<sup>m</sup> W. Wilson was proving up his 142.8 acre homestead in Hugo, Oregon in 1895.<sup>1</sup>



## The William W. Wilson Family: Federal Census

**1898 Hugo Homestead** On November 11, 1898 William W. Wilson was issued a homestead patent for 142.8 acres in Hugo, Oregon (Patent No. 4346).<sup>2-3</sup>

**1908 William Wilson Cash Entry** Wilson purchased 40 acres under Cash Entry No. 14069 in Josephine County, Oregon. It was issued March 2, 1908 to William Winchester Wilson (April 24, 1820: Sale-Cash Entry (3 Stat. 566)).<sup>2</sup>

**1910 "Three Pines Fruit Tracts"** The 1910 the old Wilson homestead was subdivided into five acre parcels where it was advertized that one could make a good living raising fruit.

After William W. Wilson sold his homestead he moved his family into Grants Pass, Oregon

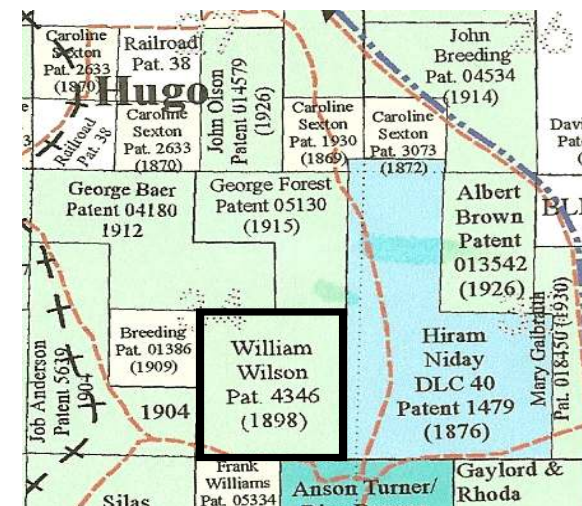
